

Slovenian Talent Point *Prva gimnazija Maribor* involved in Erasmus+ KA2 – School partnerships entitled “Brains in action – Exchanging new ways of learning and teaching for high achievers in a European school network (2016 – 2019)”



The project aims are to foster the development of *high achievers* (the term has been agreed to be used in the project), to exchange the experience and good practice amongst partner schools, to acquire new knowledge, to cooperate with some new institutions, to improve digital, language, social and intercultural competences of participating students, and to enable mobility's for students and teachers. Participating teachers received valuable expertise in this field, and this has been disseminated in their schools. The project activities raised teachers' awareness of the importance of recognising the needs of the target groups and adapting the teaching/learning and other activities. Participating students have acquired new knowledge in a variety of subject areas; they have been familiarized with life and education practices and opportunities in some European countries, while developing their communication and social competences. The expected final impact of the project is to provide a better environment for the development of talented students in participating schools.
