The Croatian Mathematics Olympiad for the cadets is a competition organized for 4th, 5th and 6th grade students and its main goal is to popularize Mathematics and encourage exceptionalism at an early age. It is organized by the Croatian Mathematics Society in cooperation with local partners (partners being schools with which Croatian Mathematics Society arranges the conduction of test taking) and for the Zadar County the partner is Primary school Stjepan Radić Bibinje. The competition was held in 2 rounds: First preliminary round was held in virtual environment on the 6th June 2020. 10 students participated in the 1st round, 2 from our school (Dino Lukić, Tome Sikirić).



The second round was held in each county throughout the Republic of Croatia on the 23rd June 2020. 4 students from our county qualified for the second round: Lovro Kličković, Adrian Graovac, Marin Mlinarić and Jakov Peroš. A student from Zagreb, Željko Đerek, has participated in the 2nd round of competition at our school because of the fact that at the moment of the 2nd round of the competition he was situated in our county.

The committee in charge of carrying out the Croatian Mathematics Olympiad for the cadets composes the tests, sends the tests to the local partners and corrects (grades) them in the 2nd round whereas the responsibility of the local partners is to ensure the conducting of the test in accordance with the epidemiologic recommendations and instructions.
